ANT	No	No divisional credit awarded; Instructor's credentials required	6hrs may be taken elsewhere in the major.
ART	No	No divisional credit awarded	3 courses (2 in major/minor concentration & 1 outside concentration)
BIO	No	No divisional credit awarded	May receive credit for BIO 113, 114, 213, or 214 only if transferred course includes a lab.
CHM	No	No divisional credit awarded	Institution must offer major in CHM to receive major/minor credit. 9hrs may be taken elsewhere for CHM minor.
CLA	Case-by-case	Does not accept online summer courses for transfer credit.
